Your first time installing this product may take up to 40 minutes. You'll get faster after each installation.



The installation procedure may involve handling high voltage wiring. Please be careful. To avoid serious personal injury, death, or property damage, turn OFF the power to the circuit and follow all safety precautions before proceeding.

Working with electricity can be dangerous. If you are unsure about, or uncomfortable with the installation, seek the help of a qualified electrician.






# **Check Compatibility**

#### **Product dimensions**



#### **Working space**

Make sure HyPanel Pro is compatible with the location where you want to install it.



SIDE VIEW: HYPANEL PRO IN WALL

**ADA Compliance Requirement** 

A 50mm(2 inches) deep electrical box is highly recommended for ease of installation. In some scenarios, especially when the wires can be pushed back into the wall far enough, it may be possible to use a 40mm(1.6 inches) deep box.

#### Input and output requirements

- For dry contacts: Max 4A at 100-240VAC per gang.
- For the digital input: 0~5VDC

### 21-30V DC auxiliary power supply required

HyPanel Pro requires a 21-30V DC auxiliary supply to operate properly.

#### **Support Wi-Fi and Ethernet connections**

HyPanel Pro can operate with both wireless and wired networks, but a wired connection is recommended for greater reliability and faster data exchange.


# Wiring


# ! Warning!

Turn OFF the circuit breaker before wiring and proceeding!

Always use a voltage detector to verify the power is OFF before wiring and installation!

#### **Rear connections**






- The Line wire (L) connects to any one of the L terminals, providing 100-240 Volts
  of power to the load devices.
- L1 and L2 are Load wires that connect the HyPanel Pro to the light bulbs or other devices, e.g., fans or curtain motors.
- KNX+ and KNX- are connected to KNX bus.
- AUX+ and AUX- provide 21-30V DC auxiliary power supply to HyPanel Pro.
- IO and GND are used to link a door bell or 0-5V sensors.

#### **Connect wires**


1 Strip and straighten wires



The line and load wires connected to HyPanel Pro should be 0.75mm<sup>2</sup> - 1.6mm<sup>2</sup> in size and must have stripped and straight ends. Remove the plastic sheathing of the wire, and make sure the exposed wire ends measure approximately 8 mm (5/16 inch) in length.



Always make sure the arrow on the front of the flush mounted module is pointing up.



Connect KNX and AUX cables to the corresponding terminals.

- · If you need to link other devices
  - Connect the Line wire into any one of the L ports.
  - → Insert the Load wire(s) to the L1 and/or L2 ports.
  - Tighten the screws clockwise with a flat-head screwdriver until wires are secure
  - Double check by gently tugging on each wire.
- · If you want to use wired network


Plug the RJ45 network cable to the Ethernet port.

If you want to link a door bell or 0-5V sensors

Insert the IO and GND wires into the terminals at the bottom of the flush mounted module.


## **Installation**

### 1 Insert screws




- Insert the supplied screws into the designated holes on the electrical box.
- Change the torque on the electric screwdriver to 5kgf.cm.
- Turn screws clockwise with the screwdriver.
- Do not fully tighten the screws. The screw head must protrude at least 3 mm (1/8 inch) from the wall surface.

### 2 Install flush mounted module




• Attach the flush mounted module to the electrical box. The screws should go through the holes on the module.




- Adjust the module to be level and ensure it is flush against the wall.
- Tighten the screws to attach the module to the wall, taking care not to over-tightened them.

### 3 Install panel

1 Turn OFF the circuit breaker before you install the panel.




Line up the two clips on the flush mounted module with the notches on the panel. Snap the panel into place and press it down.



- Check the panel is properly clipped onto the module and is flush against the wall.
- Locate the screw hole on the bottom of the panel. There is a screw already in it.
- Tighten the screw with the included hex key.

#### If you need to remove the panel

- 1.Turn the screw with the hex key until the rear edge of the panel comes loose.
- 2.Hold the panel's top with one hand, and pull the panel outwards from the bottom.
